The North Channel is the water between Manitoulan Island and the north shore of Lake Huron in Ontario. The area stretches from Sault Ste Marie in the West to Killarney in the East. This application provides a guide to identifying the various plants you may encounter on both the shoreline and in the water.

On the main screen the "Search" icon (magnifying Glass) will allow keyword searches of the database.

Selecting the "File Folder" icon will allow setting application wide options for plant location and sort order.

The "Selection " button has all search criteria on one screen for fast access.

For all other screens the following selections may appear:

"Search Database" button: The database will be searched using the current selection criteria.

"Reset" button: if available will reset all criteria and return to the start screen.

"Back" button or a right swipe: if available will return to the last screen viewed.

Detail selections may be deleted by using the "Remove Item" button if available or by unchecking the criteria row.

The final screen from the database search contains a text field that summarizes the search criteria used to select the matching items from the database.

NOTE: Selecting nothing will show entire database contents.
